

# **REQUIRED TOOLS**

Metric and SAE Socket Sets and Wrenches

## **INCLUDED HARDWARE**

- (2) Frame Brackets
- (6) 1/2" Grade 8 Bolts
- (12) 1/2" Washers
- (6) 1/2" Lock Washers
- (6) 1/2" Hex Nuts





### **CHEVROLET**

- 1 Remove tow hooks
- 2 Insert bracket and tow hooks reusing factory hardware leave loose for adjustment
- Install Brush Guard using supplied 1/2" hardware. Brackets sit on the 3
- Align and tighten all hardware once satisfied with fitment.












### **GMC**

- 1 Remove dust cover above grill
- 2 Remove 4 bolts on top of grill
- 3
- 4
- 5
- 6
- 7 Remove 1 top bolt at a time to slide bumper out so the bracket can slide under the frame.















- 8 Install tow hooks
- 9 Reinstall all factory hardware leaving brackets loose
- 10 Reinstall grill and dust cover in reverse order
- 11 Install Brush Guard using supplied 1/2" hardware.
- Align and tighten all hardware once satisfied with fitment.
