




- 1 Unplug bumper wiring harness from the body harness
- 2 Remove (4) 13mm bolts each side of outer bumper support gussets
- 3 Remove under-run guards from both frame rails (18mm bolts)
- 4 Remove bolts from front by each tow hook to remove bumper
- **5** Remove both factory tow hooks using 15mm socket. Cut Flange off Tow Hook.



















- 6 Fit up Road Armor bracket with factory tow hook and bolt on
- 7 Push on retainer clips using a deep socket, one per side for easier mating of bumper to bracket.
- 8 Disconnect factory fog light and separate harness from bumper and set aside
- 9 Remove fog lights as shown then re-install them into Vaquero bumper in reverse order // or LED cube



- 10 Get the bumper stabilized on a pallet lift or table cart for safest install
- 11 Fit up bumper to brackets aligning the retained bolts with bracket slots
- 12 Once centered and satisfied with fitment tighten everything down
- 13 The center section is designed to accommodate a 20-inch light bar. If you one to install do this now.
- 4 Now install the modular non-winch center plate. It slides up from the bottom and bolts through the sides as shown.
