## REQUIRED TOOLS

Metric and SAE Socket Sets and Wrenches

Tools to splice wiring

### **INCLUDED HARDWARE**

- (4) 1/2" x 1.5" Grade 8 Bolt Plates
- (4) 1/2" Washers
- (4) 1/2" Lock Washers
- (4) 1/2" Hex Nutes
- (2) Keeper Washers
- (2) License plate lights & Tapered hardware
- (1) Stainless Steel Road Armor Logo Letters and Bolt Kit



- 1 Remove two nuts and bolts each side to remove OEM bumper and save hardware
- 2 Install brackets to frame as shown both sides re-using factory hardware
- 3 Install license plate lights putting wires through center hole as shown.
- 4 Installation of winch and reverse lights is much easier at this stage as well.
- **NOTE** Wiring of the license plate lights, winch and reverse lights are done at your discretion.
  - 5 Insert a bolt tab through bumper each side and push on retainer washer using a deep socket.
  - 6 Fit up bumper and install remaining hardware.
  - 7 Adjust the bumper on slots. Once satisfied with fitment tighten down hardware. Done.
