

- (8) 1/4" Stainless Button Head Hex Drive Bolts
- (8) 1/4" K-Lock Nuts
- (4) #8-32 Stainless Flat Head Socket Drive Bolts
- (4) #8-32 K-Lock Nuts
- (4) #10-24 Stainless Button Head Socket Drive Bolts

- (4) #10-24 K-Lock Nuts
- (4) 1 1/8" Dome Plugs
- (1) License Plate Hardware kit
- (1) Trailer Plug Adapter Plate
- (2) License Plate Lights














- 1 Remove wiring and sensors from factory bumper
- 2 Remove 5 bolts per side as shown
- Using a ratcheting wrench ideally, remove bolts next to license plate lights
- There are 4 tabs that need to be pushed through bracket to remove the bumper
- Bend down the bracket above the receiver hitch or cut where the dotted line is located.






- Remove OEM Triple Nut Plate one side at a time.
- 9 Cut OEM Triple Nut Plate as shown.









10 Install bottom OEM bolt and secure.

Repeat steps 7 through 10 to the opposite side.









- 11 Install hardware connecting frame bracket to bumper as shown. Make sure the top bolt tab is facing outward.
- 12 Install sensors, trailer light plug (Install plug where the cylinder on the back is on the bottom), and lighting options onto the bumper.
- 13 Insert OEM hardware into the bracket facing away from bumper.
- 14 Install bumper checking bumper alignment and tighten down.
- After the bumper is installed pull wires for license plate light through holes and splice in supplied aftermarket lights. Plug in wires that have been disconnected.
