

- 1 Remove the rubber shroud from tow hook pulling forward. This takes some force.
- Remove front bolt from tow hook, then rear bolt. The tow hook will slide off once the rear is loose.
- 3 Brackets install as shown. Passenger on Left, Driver on Right.
- **A** Fit up bracket to Driver side. Install rear bolt first, then slide on tow hook.
- Install forward bolt next then snug but don't fully tighten to allow adjustment.
- **6** Repeat for Passenger side.



- 7 Fit up brush / grille guard to outside of brackets then install all hardware as shown.
- NOTE Do not fully tighten any hardware until satisfied with fitment.
  - The brush guard with have rotational, up / down and side to side adjustment still. Center it and check headlight reveal then begin by tightening the tow hooks, then the top bolt on either side of the brush guard.
- 9 Congratulations! All done. If you have lights to install, now would be the time.
