




4 3/8 POLYCARBONATE PUSH PLUG



- Unplug fog light harness if equipped. Remove the bolts on the back side of the factory bumper. Now remove the bolts from the bumper to the side of the frame. Remove the bolt holding the tow hooks in place and remove tow hook.
- Place the Road Armor Bracket on the inside of the frame and place tow hook on top of the bracket. Using OEM hardware attach the bracket and tow hooks. These bolts should be finger tight.
- Align the Road Armor brackets with the front of the frame horn and tighten the tow hook completely.
- Place the 1/2" bolt tabs into the inner 2 bolt holes of the frame bracket facing forwards. Secure in place with push nut retainers.
- 5 Install aftermarket lights or OEM fog lights.
 - If you are installing the OEM fog lights the wiring harness will need to be extended.
- Place the bumper on the truck and secure using the 1/2" hardware. Leave a little loose for adjustment.







- Adjust the bumper up/down and left/right and fully tighten the inner bolts.
- Place the 1/2" bolt tabs into the outer slots of the brackets and fully tighten.



- 9 Install light bar onto the non winch center section plate.
- 10 Install the non winch center section plate onto the bumper using the 3/8" hardware.
