(Only for models that have optional skid plate)

- 4 1/4" x 0.625" OD Low Carbon Zinc Finish Steel SAE General Purpose Flat Washer
- 10 3/8" x 0.812" OD Low Carbon Zinc Finish Steel SAE General Purpose Flat Washer
- 2 3/8" Zinc Finish Medium Split Lock Washer
- 2 3/8"-16 Zinc Finish Grade 5 Finished Hex Nut
- 3 5/16"-12 x 1" Hex Unslotted Drive Indented Hex Washer Head Zinc Finish #3 Point Steel Self-Drilling Screw



# This is to be installed after the bumper.

1	Remove factory skid plate from vehicle. This will involve removing 2 bolts from the crossmember and 2 to 3 bolts on the mounting location toward the front of the vehicle.
2	Connect the main body of the skid plate with the bracket.
	(Note: Stock suspension bracket will have 2 slots)
	(Note: Lifted suspension bracket will have 3 holes)
3	Place the skid plate onto the top part of the lower bumper and use 3/8" button head
	bolts to secure. Align skid plate and tighten the section under the bumper.
	Apply lubrication the stainless hardware before installation
	Stock Suspension directions
4a	Align bracket with factory mounting location on suspension crossmember. Use factory hardware to attack lower part of skid plate assembly and tighten.
	Lifted Suspension directions
4b	Alight bracket to aftermarket crossmember. Use (3) 5/16 self-drilling screws to secure the bracket.
5	Tighten the 3/8" hardware connecting the main body of the skid plate to the bracket.

Note: When removing the skid plate for maintenance remove the 2 bolts holding the skid plate to the bracket and the bolts on the bottom side of the bumper.
